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Ovarian Dermoid Cyst

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ABSTRACT

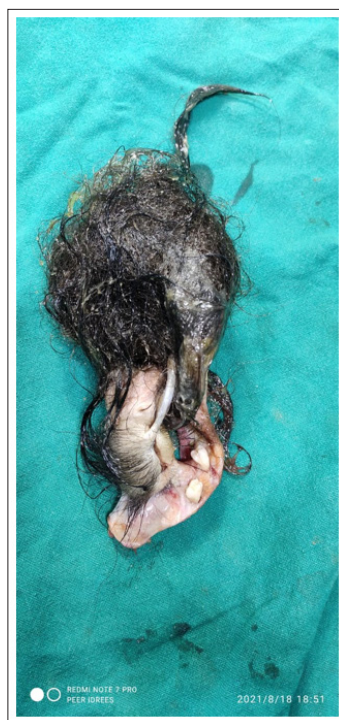
Objective: Teratoma is the most common germ cell tumor of the ovary.

Clinical Picture: A 35 years-old woman visited outpatient clinic because of lower abdominal pain. Clinical examination and Ultrasonographic revealed a heterogeneous cystic mass in the left ovary with calcification within. Abdominopelvic CT scan revealed a left ovarian heterogeneous mass (16×16 cm) with calcified structure within the mass. Left adnexectomy was performed. Cut section showed partially formed Mandible with teeth, partially formed external ear and tuft of hair (image 1). The pathological evaluation suggested benign ovarian dermoid. Conclusion: dermoid should be considered as a differential diagnosis whenever a patient with a documented pelvic mass.
