The brain is Newtonian physics whereas the soul (mind) is quantum physics (wave particle duality, outside of time). (A) Light from different distance points hits the retina and travels through the neurological system such that there is interaction between waves of electricity. Sometimes there will be constructive interference between wave peaks and sometimes there will be destructive interference. The time distance relationship between for instance constructive peaks is measured by the neurological system to determine depth perception. This is additional to historic explanations including texture gradient, parallax and interposition. (B) The transposition of the inverted image historically has been described using Newtonian physics. The light rays from objects coming toward the eye based on angle of incidence and angle of reflection. Light rays from higher up beaming downward to the bottom of the retina and light from lower down beaming upward and hitting higher on the retina. This forming the inverted image. The current researcher describes the inverted image by introducing the circular (sinusoidal) function of the light time curve (introducing the curved nature of light time). Light undergoes a circular revolution of $\pi/2$ around $y = x$ and a circular revolution of $\pi/2$ around $y = -x$. This circular revolution of light time forms the inverted image.

(C) The third proof is for particle form but due to protecting valuable IP the researcher is not stating whether pinhole increases diffraction or collapses waveform into particle. Placement of the pinhole can be described as increasing the collapse of the wave into particle and thereby increasing concentration of light on the retina thereby increasing visual acuity. This is on top of historical explanations that placement of the pinhole increases visual acuity by only allowing the central beam through which is unaffected by refractive errors.
